Julius Evola, come si legge nell'ultima pagina del suo libro, concluse "Teoria e fenomenologia dell'Individuo assoluto" nel 1924: uscirà in due tomi solo tre e sei anni dopo, mentre il giovane pensatore si stava già da tempo occupando di altro. È il periodo intensissimo dei suoi scritti e delle sue polemiche in ambiente esoterico-occultistico, filosofico-accademico e religioso-protestante. Anche se sono apparsi diversi saggi su questi anni che vanno grosso modo dal 1924 al 1931 (diciamo dalla uscita della versione del "Tao tè ching" alla conclusione dell'esperienza del Gruppo di Ur), nonché siano state pubblicate alcune sue antologie di scritti dell'epoca, manca ancora uno studio organico specificatamente dedicato a questi tumultuosi cinque-sei anni ricchi di incontri e di scontri, di analisi e di polemiche, di conferme e ripensamenti. Un periodo decisivo per la formazione della "visione del mondo" del giovane pensatore, fra i 26 e i 33 anni. Adesso si aggiunge questo volume che inserisce un altro titolo nella collana delle sue "Opere". Nelle bibliografie evoliane, a cominciare da quelle compilate dallo stesso interessato, è sempre presente "L'individuo e il divenire del mondo", che in realtà...
