The various cases of Simple Interest are, as a rule, so badly learnt, that I think it advisable to give a short summary of them, with rules suitable for committing to memory. In Interest questions we have to consider four items, viz. the Principal, Rate per cent, Time, and Interest (or Amount). When any three of these are given it is possible to find the fourth. Let us consider them seriatim. Case 1.--Having given the Principal, Time, and Rate per cent, to find the Interest. Rule.--Multiply the Principal by the number of years, and the product by the Rate per cent, and divide by 100. This is the ordinary well-known rule, and needs no comment. N.B.--If the Amount be required, add together the...



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
