Theodore de Beze, one of the leaders of the Reformation in France, lived there with his friend, Noel de Muirc. Take the Rue du Marc, which continues the Rue du Grenier-a-Sd (photo above). The Rue du Marc was the quarter where the old noble families and the higher bourgeois of Rheima lived. It suffered considerably from the bombardments. At No. 3 is a Henry IV. house, the windows of which are framed with graceful ornamentation (photo below). However, the...
