Excerpt: .The ring toss board should be made according to the following measurements: Base two feet square; five posts, one at each corner, eight inches in height, the centre post ten inches in height; five rings, eight inches in diameter, made from firm rope. For beginners chalk a starting line six feet from the board; as the children improve the distance may be increased. Children should be seated on small chairs in a half-circle. Place the board in the front of class, mark the starting line. Teacher will call upon the players one at a time, have them stand on the chalk line and throw rings in an effort to get them on the posts.
